Smiles For Life is an annual fund raiser organized by the women at the college of dentistry which provides funding for dental care for the women and children of the Bluegrass Domestic Violence Center for the year. The care provided ranges from simple cleanings and school exams for the children to cancer screenings, replacement of missing teeth, and even facial reconstruction for the mothers. Smiles For Life includes a CE course in the morning for local dentists, a brunch, a fashion show, and a silent auction. The event usually has over 250 people in attendance and raises about \$10,000.
